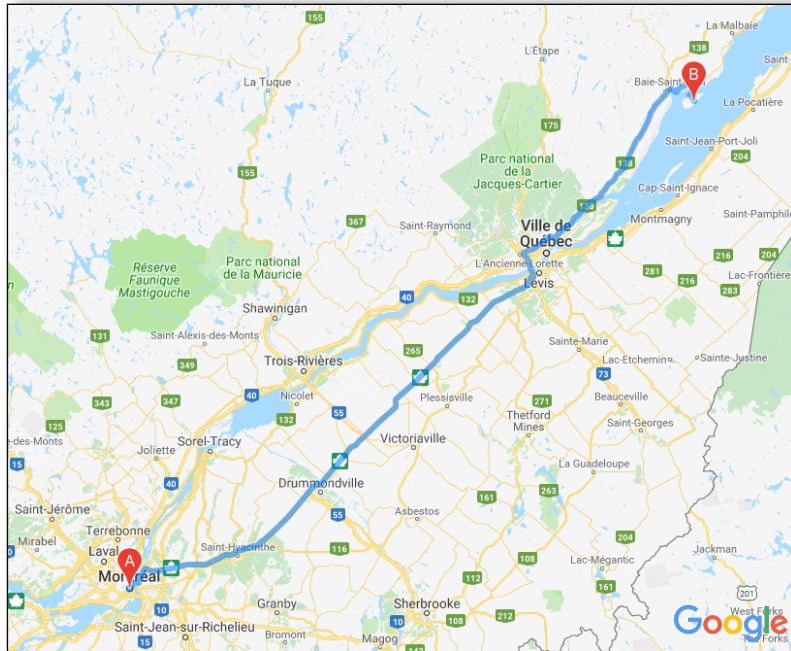


HOW TO GET TO ISLE-AUX-COUDRES



From Montreal to Quebec City

-Take Exit 196S to Highway 40E/Highway 55S towards Trois-Rivières/Centre-Ville/Québec. (240km).

From Quebec City to Isle-aux-Coudres

-Take Highway 440E.

-Take Exit 15 towards Highway Robert-Bourassa N/Highway 740N

-Take Exit 9E to get to Highway 40E/Highway 73N towards Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré/Saguenay

-Get onto Highway 40E/Highway 440E

-Continue on Boulevard Sainte-Anne/QC-138E and take Exit Québec 362E towards Les Éboulements/L'Isle-aux-Coudres

-Continue on Route 362E and turn right onto Route du Port, and then onto Rang des Éboulements Centre

-Continue on Rue Félix Antoine and then bear slightly left on what becomes Chemin du Quai.

Arrival at the Ferry linking Saint-Joseph-de-la-Rive with Isle-aux-Coudres at St-Bernard-sur-Mer.

Montreal/QuebecCity/Isle-aux-Coudres - about 4 hrs 30 min. (380km)



Quebec City/Baie-Saint-Paul/Les Éboulements/Saint-Joseph-de-la-Rive - about 2 hrs 15 min. (140km)



ISLE-AUX-COUDRES FERRY

Saint-Joseph-de-la-Rive/Isle-aux-Coudres

Free Ferry Service. Crossing Time: 20 minutes.

Summer: Departures every 30 minutes (from 9am to 6pm)

Departures every hour (from 7am to 9am and 6pm to 11:30pm)

Saint-Bernard-sur-Mer/Isle-aux-Coudres

-Drive North-East on Chemin des Coudriers towards Chemin de la Bourroche, bear slightly right onto Chemin de la Baleine.

***Hôtel Cap-aux-Pierres 444, Chemin de la Baleine,
L'Isle-aux-Coudres (about 7 minutes, once on the island)***
