Honorary Life Members

Éric R. Mercier

Member of the Québec National Assembly for Charlesbourg

Éric R. Mercier was born On October 3, 1967. He is married with Caroline Arsenault.

After his primary and secondary education, he attended college at the Notre-de-Foy campus in Saint-Augustin-de-Desmaures, South of Québec City and then went on to study at Laval University in Québec City.

In 1991, he obtained a first Bachelor's degree in Communications and Public Relations, with a minor in Industrial Relations and a second Bachelor's degree in Political Sciences in 1996.

After completing his university education, Éric worked in the public communications area. He enrolled in the Canadian Armed Forces and enlisted for a training and leadership course leading to an Officer's status. In 1998, he was commissioned as an Officer with the leadership and recruits school for the Armed Forces in Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu.

During 1998 and 1999, he trained in surface and sub-marine operations at the Marine Officers' Training Centre in Victoria, B.C. He also underwent training in marine operations control at the Canadian Navy School in Halifax, N.S. and in Québec City in 2000-2001.

In 1998, he served as an Officer on the large sailing vessel NCSM Oriole and then on the frigate NCSM Ottawa as a second Officer in 1999-2000. He then returned to Québec City and worked in the public relations Department of Navy Reserve Headquarters in the old port of Québec. He acted at the same time as divisional Officer in the NCSM Montcalm naval training unit.

In 2002, Éric became assistant director of communications at the office of the opposition municipal party in Québec City. He retained that position until his election as a member of the Québec National Assembly for the constituency of Charlesbourg on April 14. 2003.

Following his election, Éric has been named a member of the Commission on Culture, a member of the Commission on Education, a member of the Commission on Labour and Trade and a member of the National Assembly Office, where he

Lauréat Mercier

Lauréat was born in May 1932.

After his primary education in Sainte-Sabine-de-Bellechasse, he obtained a college degree in accounting with distinction from Académie de Québec.

He entered Laval University in Québec City where he qualified as a Certified General Accountant and obtained the professional designation of C.G.A.

1953 and 1954 saw him in public practice for an accounting firm and then joined the office of the Auditor General to wotk in Québec City and Montréal.

From 1975 to 1987, he worked for the Québec Port Authority as comptroller and then, Director of Finance.

He is married with Gisèle Turmel and thay have two children who live in the Québec City area.

Upon his retirement, he returned to Sainte-Sabine, which is also the place of origin of his wife.

He volunteers for audit assignments for non-profit organisations such as A.M. A.N.

Robert Mercier

Robert has been honoured in 1999 in Montmagny, but his certificate was not available at that time.

Robert has worked more than 40 years to assemble a data bank on some 62,000 Mercier individuals or their relatives. His detailed history has been published in Le Mercien in the Winter issue of 1999 (vol. 15, no. 4).

Our soon to be published dictionary of Mercier Families will be largely inpired by his research.




A.M.A.N. paid tribute to those who devoted themselves to its activities over the past twenty years and handed them a certificate of honour in recognition for their valuable work.








Lotomatique

Loto-Québec has a special offer for Lotomatique participants and members.

The AMAN is a member accredited by Loto-Québec. To be eligible for the draw you need only be a participant. Furthermore, the AMAN can also win a prize.

For a period of 6 months starting September 26, 2005, Lotomatique will draw each month 18 prizes of \$250 among its participants. The AMAN can win \$100 each time one of the 18 prizes is awarded. In other words, if you win \$250, the AMAN wins automatically \$100, and you can win more than once. Participants need an address in the province of Quebec.

Although we are soliciting our members directly, no one is obligated to participate. The Board has decided to send its members a participation form for Lotomatique. The advantage for AMAN is a 14% commission on all subscriptions, which represented more than 10% of our income for the year ending June 30, 2005. This is not a trivial amount.

Lotomatique offers many advantages for people who regularly play 6/49, Quebec 49, Super 7 and Extra. As its name suggests, participation in the draw, verification of winning numbers and payment to winners is done automatically. When a group is the subscriber, like the AMAN is, Lotomatique divides up the payment between the participants and mails them a cheque.

The form is easy to fill up when you follow the instructions.

In my opinion these statements represent accurately the financial position of AMAN according to accounting procedures generally recognized and applied in the same ways as they were in the previous years.

New membership fee structure

The board of directors has adopted a new method for paying annual membership fees, in order to reduce the amount of clerical work.

After due consideration, it was agreed that all annual membership fees would be due on the same date of June 1st for all regular members. This date seemed most appropriate, since a large number of memberships mature on May 31. Therefore, fewer members will be affected by the transition measures.

As a result, members whose maturity date is already May 31st, there is no change. Those with a different maturity date will pay only an amount proportional to the numbers of months from their due date to May 31, 2006.

Subsequently, all annual renewals will become due on May 31 of each year. This will be easier for all members and for the association. There will be no reminders sent by mail to every member and Le Mercien will carry a notice that the annual membership fee is due for everyone.

To find out when your annual fee expires, look at the first line of the mailing label on your copy of Le Mercien. For instance, if it reads "Member no. 0000 a 2005/09/30", it means that your membership expires on September 30 of this year. Therefore, the amount that will be billed to you from that date until May 31, 2006 is \$16.67.


