It is also where I went to elementary school, as well as high school, and where I became a scout, as well as an army cadet, played various sports, etc.

The second word, Water, is also important because the St. Lawrence river is where I played, swam, canoed, fished and then worked. Also, when I went back to school, it was to study water sanitation technology, and afterwards I worked for a year in Fermont, in Northern Quebec, and then I started working for the City of Lévis, at the drinking water treatment plant for the Desjardins arrondissement, where I worked for 32 happy years.

It is also in Lévis that my two beautiful daughters, Myriam and Maryse Mercier were born from my first marriage, and I am still living there with my spouse Johanne Couture. I have two passions: sport fishing in a river or lake, which I have been doing all my life, and of course genealogy, for the last fifteen years or so.

Since late 2017, with the help of other Board members and non-Board members of our Association, I have worked to update the website of the Association des Mercier d'Amérique, in the interests of all of us.

## TRIBUTE TO JEAN, NO. 1524

Jean Mercier was born in Montreal. A resident of Saint-Jérôme for more than 80 years, he was very involved in several of his city's organizations. He was a founding member of the local Optimist Club and was even a president of the club at some point. A born president, he oversaw the running of our Association as its president from 2011 to 2015. During his term, he helped to get our Association better known through the genealogy fairs in Trois-Rivières and Québec City, continuing the work done by his predecessors.

Since 2011, the general meetings have become the work of the Board. He showed how it could be done in his first year as president, when he organized the meeting in Saint-Jérôme, adding a novel idea by using "historical characters" such as the famous priest *Curé Labelle* and the railway station master. Then in 2012, the gathering was in Saint-Georges, where with Céline and Gilmond as the lead team, I got my first try at organizing the Mercier gathering. In 2013, he drove back and forth between his residence in Saint-Jérôme and Nicolet in order to organize the annual meeting. The following year it was in Lévis and the mileage on his car is proof of all that work. Finally, in 2015, in Saint-Roch-de-l'Achigan, Lise St-André teamed up with him to organize our annual gathering. All of that represents a lot of work and research with the other members of the Board, while still ensuring the proper financial management of our association.

In 2015, the culmination of all his work was his greatest achievement, namely the publication of the genealogical index of the Merciers of North America, which is in 2 Tomes and includes more than 80,000 names. The *index* had been started in the 1990s by Benoît, Robert and Roger, and was published thanks to a special collaboration by Laurent.

Jean did exemplary work on the final editing of the books. Thanks to his openness to new technologies, the newsletter *Le Mercien* became available on line during his term as president.

For all those years of work and passion for the Association, I am pleased, on behalf of the Board and all our members, to name you an Honorary Member.

Thank you for your generosity, your devotion and your passion.
